### **MANDATORY FEES**

- Class Pre-Entry Fee - **\$8 per class**
- Ground Fee per horse - **\$10 per horse**

### **HAY AND MANURE**

- Fletcher Park is a Flora and Fauna reserve. Hay & manure **MUST** be taken home **OR** placed in receptacle at top of bays.

### **CAMPING FEES**

- \$10 per person
- Please indicate on the entry form if you require camping on Saturday evening November 25.

### **MANDATORY FORMS**

- Exhibitor Waiver (waiver to be sent in with pre-entries or provided at secretary office when entering on the day)
- Copy of Horse Registration & Memberships (sent in with pre-entries or provided at secretary office when entering on the day)
- PIC Number must be provided also on entry forms
- **Event Facility Fee:** All competitors must pay the compulsory, non-refundable event facility fee of \$10 per horse at the time of entry.

### **COVID and SHOW RULES**

- All Competitors, helpers, committee **MUST** test if you have symptoms once positive isolate for 5 days minimum. If symptom free after 5 days, then free to attend the show
- People & competitors must keep the 1.5 metre rule from each other
- There is **NO** entries on the day, Pre-Entries only
- All horse or ponies must wear a number that is clear and visible to our stewards. Numbers will be issued by the AHHA in an email once entries are processed
- Ribbons will be given for the first 3 placing's except where otherwise specified
- Junior competitors in the harness classes **MUST** wear an approved safety helmet
- Organiser reserves the right to measure an exhibit should a dispute arise
- Stallion/colts must be bitted/restrained under adult supervision at all times (persons over 17yrs). Failure to do so may result in being asked to leave
- The committee reserves the right to reject or refuse any competitor entry
- **All horses will be judged under their official breed** standard and should be presented correctly for their breed
- Cruelty to, or the abuse of any animal, by any person at this event is forbidden and an offender may be subject to withdrawal from further event classes
- Judge's decision is final
- All horses must compete drug free
- An Exhibitor showing an animal which appears unsound, or showing signs of lameness, exhaustion or distress may be asked to withdraw immediately from further competition
- Horses may not be left tied up and unattended
- Age of Horses: The age of horses will date from 1st August.
- Age of Competitors: Taken on the day of the event
- No refund on entry fees, facility fee, or stables
- All competitors enter at their own risk
- The AHHA is not responsible for any damage or loss of property
- The judge's decision is final.

## HARNESSES CLASSES

### RING THREE (SAND ARENA) – Judge: TBA

97. **Heavy Horse Long Rein - Junior Driver**

**Under 18 years old.** The horse/s can either be harnessed in winkers, long reins, collar, hames, backband (optional) and trace chains, spider harness **OR** just long reins and bridle.

98. **Heavy Horse Long Rein - Beginner Driver**

Open only to those competitors who have **NOT** won a 1st place ribbon in a beginner long rein class. If placed 2<sup>nd</sup> or fewer competitors in past classes, then this does not apply.

The horse/s can either be harnessed in winkers, long reins, collar, hames, backband (optional) and trace chains, spider harness **OR** long reins and harness.

99. **Heavy Horse Open Long Rein Driver (18yrs and over)**

The horse/s can either be harnessed in winkers, long reins, collar, hames, backband (optional) and trace chains, spider harness **OR** just long reins and bridle. **Cannot compete in beginner**

100. **Heavy Horse Long Rein - Beginner Horse**

Horse has never won a first place at a working show. The horse/s can either be harnessed in winkers, long reins, collar, hames, backband (optional) and trace chains, spider harness **OR** just long reins and bridle.

101. **Heavy Horse Long Rein - Open Horse**

The horse/s can either be harnessed in winkers, long reins, collar, hames, backband (optional) and trace chains, spider harness **OR** just long reins and bridle. **Cannot compete in beginner horse as well.**

102. **Heavy Horse Led Horse - Led Obstacle Course (horse any age)**

This event is open to any horses. The horse must be in a halter and lead and entire male horses over 12 months must have a bit in their mouth. A show cane or similar may be used to help guide your horse, but the cane must not exceed 1.2m in length. **Using the cane to hit the horse will result in immediate disqualification.**

Points will be lost if the horse refuses any part of the course or if any part of the course is knocked or eaten. This is a timed event around an obstacle course and penalties per fault apply. A clear round without penalties will beat a timed round with penalties. This is a horsemanship class not a speed event, but a total time limit on the course may be set.

103. **Heavy Horse Long Rein - Junior Driver Obstacle**

A competitor must be 17 years and under on the first day of competition. Proof of age may be required. All competitors must be closely attended by an adult at all times whilst competing. This adult must be a competent horse handler. Competitors shall negotiate obstacle courses as directed by the Judge.

Penalties are incurred for mistakes or if Junior is assisted in any way by the adult. The horse must be driven at a walk, trotting will incur penalties, except in a wheeled vehicle and cantering will result in disqualification.

104. **Heavy Horse Long Rein - Driving Obstacle Course**

The horse/s can either be harnessed in winkers, long reins, collar, hames, backband (optional) and trace chains, spider harness **OR** long reins and harness. Competitors shall negotiate obstacle courses as directed by the judge.

Points will be lost if the horse or harness touch any part of the course. The course must be driven from the ground, while walking beside or behind the horse. Any break into a trot will be penalised, a break into canter or gallop will be disqualified. Shouting and whipping is not allowed. This is a timed event and penalties per fault apply. A clear round without penalties will beat a timed round with penalties. Fewest faults within a given time is the priority.

105. **Cone Driving Obstacle course**

Cone driving is open to all heavy and light horses and ponies in long rein driving.

**Cone knock down = 5 Second Penalty, Missing a Cone set or entering via the reverse side = 5 Second Penalty, Failing to pass through the start/finish = 5 Second Penalty.** Cones width will be 190 cm. There are no exclusions, except where there is a safety or welfare issue identified by the judge.

AUSTRALIAN HEAVY HORSE ASSOCIATION advise that participation in horse sports at an agricultural show or horse competition contains elements of risk, both obvious and inherent. Horse sports are dangerous recreational activities and horses can act in a sudden and unpredictable way, especially when frightened or hurt.

### **By signing this waiver, I acknowledge that:**

1. participation in horse sports is a hazardous activity and may result in injury, loss, damage or death to me
2. participation in horse sports requires certain skills. I declare that I have sufficient skills to be able to safely and properly participate in the events
3. horses can act in a sudden and unpredictable way, especially if frightened or hurt, or if exposed to loud or unfamiliar noises
4. if held at an agricultural show, the horse sports will be held in close proximity to rides and large groups of people, and that there may be loud and unfamiliar noises which can frighten horses
5. as the event is held outdoors, there are risks to me and to my horse as a result of the weather conditions, including either extreme hot or cold weather, rain or wind
6. insects or other animals may cause my horse or other horses to become frightened and act in an unpredictable way
7. there is inherent in horse riding events the risk of suffering injury including falling from my horse
8. I am responsible for ensuring that I have and will wear equipment suitable for safely and properly participating in the event; and
9. I use the facilities of this event entirely at my own risk, as I find them and with the prior acceptance of the risk of possible danger to me
  - 9.1 If I suffer harm while participating in a horse event, I will not hold the Suppliers, their employees or agents legally responsible for any injuries I suffer. I will not sue the Suppliers, their employees or agents for any claims, costs, damages or liability. I agree to release the Suppliers and their employees from legal responsibility for the services I have been provided
  - 9.2 I acknowledge and agree that my participation in the horse sports and associated activities are a danger and may have inherent risks as a result of which personal injury (and sometimes death) may occur and I accept and assume all such risks of personal injury or death in anyway whatsoever arising from these activities and hereby waive my individual right to sue the Suppliers for all claims I or my representatives may have for such personal injury or death against the Suppliers in regard to their negligence, breach of statutory duty or statutory guarantees arising from or in connection with these activities to the fullest extent permitted by law
  - 9.3 I will not consume any alcohol or illicit drugs while participating in the horse sports and agree that such use may result in me being excluded from an event with no entitlement to any refund of money paid for entry to the Suppliers
10. I agree to be bound by the rules and guidelines.

Under the Australian Consumer Law (Western Australia), several statutory guarantees apply to the supply of certain goods and services. These guarantees mean that the supplier named on this form is required to ensure that the recreational services it supplies to you:

- are rendered with due care and skill; and
  
- are reasonably fit for any purpose which you, either expressly or by implication, make known to the supplier; and
  
- might reasonably be expected to achieve any result you have made known to the supplier.

Under section 32N of the **Fair Trading Act 1999**, the supplier is entitled to ask you to agree that these statutory guarantees do not apply to you. If you sign this form, you will be agreeing that your rights to sue the supplier under the **Fair Trading Act 1999** if you are killed or injured because the services provided were not in accordance with these guarantees, are excluded, restricted or modified in the way set out in this form.

**NOTE:** The change to your rights, as set out in this form, does not apply if your death or injury is due to gross negligence on the supplier's part. **Gross Negligence** is defined in the Fair Trading (Recreational Services) Regulations 2004.
